
### 2019 NJ Minimum Size, Possession Limits & Seasons

Fish are measured from tip of snout to tip of tail (except Black Seabass & Sharks) Cleaning/filleting of fish with a minimum size limit while at sea is prohibited, With the exception of strips taken off one fluke per day to be used THAT day as bait.




Weakfish 1 Fish at 13 inches Jan 1 - Dec 31








Black Sea Bass

# STRIPED BASS

HOW TO MEASURE Close mouth, pinch tail to get maximum length. Make sure tape/ruler is FLAT, arching over the fish can add an inch that isn't




