# Sunshine Foundation Angler Survey Report 2007-2013

Thanks to those of you who have participated in the catch vs. effort survey for the past seven years. One of the results of the survey has been the reduction of the size limit to 17 1/2". Here is a summary report of the information you have reported.

NOAA has a new system for counting the number of fish caught by recreational anglers. It remains to be seen how good the new system will be. In the meantime you can help by participating in surveys like this. Only with sufficient data can the recreational catch be estimated. Please participate this year.

You should also get in the habit of filling out the catch vs. effort survey on the NJ Division of Fish and Wildlife website. That information will help New Jersey show the National Marine Fisheries Service what the status of the stocks really is in New Jersey.
